

THE WEEK IN REVIEW

6th Grade Earth and Space Science & Geography

During Science class this week, sixth graders completed their notes on H-R Diagrams and created their in-class activities. They presented their activities on Friday. The class was also given a cross word puzzle and review worksheet to prepare for the upcoming test next week.

In Geography, the students began the next chapter focusing on Canada! They completed graphic organizers on the physical landscape and bodies of water. The students were also given a map and a checklist of information to know.

Sixth graders turned in their topic proposals for History day. I'm excited for this year's projects!

7th Grade Life Science & Early U.S. History

The seventh graders finished their notes on world Biomes and began to construct their projects. The students also turned in their Science Fair notebooks to be evaluated. The next step is writing a research summary. We will work on this in school next week.

In history class, the students practiced (and practiced, and practiced!) the Preamble to the Constitution. They took their quiz on Wednesday. The class began to take notes on the American Revolution.

8th Grade Physical Science & Modern U.S. History

In science class this week, eighth graders practiced using coefficients and subscripts to determine the number of elements and atoms in a molecule. They completed notes and their in-class activities. The class also reviewed and took a small quiz on the material.

The eighth grade class completed notes for the lesson and worked on their research activity. The students examined the United States' role in various negotiations and will be writing a short essay on whether they feel America acted as a bully or as a world leader.
