

## THE WEEK IN REVIEW

### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Earth and Space Science & Geography

In Science class this week, sixth graders began their in-class activities on eclipses and presented them to the class. They received a study guide and a practice sheet to help them study for their upcoming quiz! They should be reviewing a little bit every night!

In Geography the students made corrections to their tests and began the second half of the unit. This half focuses on the history of the eastern half of the United States and the culture. The class learned new vocabulary words and completed notes.

### 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Life Science & Early U.S. History

The seventh graders practiced drawing food webs and learned about the unique ecosystem at the bottom of the ocean floor. They received a study guide for their upcoming test and practiced identifying the different parts of a food chain. The students also reviewed key vocabulary terms.

The class started off the week in social studies making corrections to their quiz- Exploring the Americas and then began to take a closer look at the beginning of the English colonies in America. They're making connections between the history we're learning in class and the history they learned in preparation for the Renaissance Faire!

### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Physical Science & Modern U.S. History

The eighth graders completed their test on reactivity and made corrections. They began the next chapter which takes a closer look at metals, nonmetals, and metalloids, their properties, and their uses.

In history class, the eighth grade made corrections to their assessments and began to read the next chapter about the rise in urbanization during the late 1800s and early 1900s. They had a mini-debate on the immigration policy in America at the time. The students also learned more about the culture at the time and the vast differences between economic classes.
