### 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Earth and Space Science & Geography

During Science class this week, sixth graders completed their notes and began their in-class activities about the Life Cycle of a Star.

In Geography, the students continued to take notes and focus on the vocabulary for the third lesson. They learned about the groups of people who lived in the American West in its early history.
