

THE WEEK IN REVIEW

6th Grade Earth and Space Science & Geography

In Science class this week, sixth graders finished taking notes on the lunar phases. They practiced making predictions about upcoming phases and learned the average number of days between each one. The class also started to create products to demonstrate their knowledge of lunar phases.

In Geography the class completed their study guide and played a review game. They took their first test on Thursday! On Friday, they made corrections and previewed their next unit- The United States!

7th Grade Life Science & Early U.S. History

The seventh graders continued to take notes on limiting factors and abiotic and biotic competitions in ecosystems. They began an activity where they study an ecosystem from Pennsylvania and report on its formation and factors.

The class continued their Native American unit with an examination of the culture of the Iroquois and Algonquian tribes. They learned about the role of women and the use of resources. The class also began their study guide for the upcoming test.

8th Grade Physical Science & Modern U.S. History

The eighth graders worked on an activity to demonstrate their knowledge of atoms. They then presented their products to the class. Eighth graders also began their study guide for the upcoming test.

In history class, the 8th grade completed and reviewed their campaign projects! They discussed strategies and use of resources. The class was also given a study guide to complete and reviewed for their test which they took on Thursday!
